"Why a Man?"

Preached by Bro. Mahlon T. LeCroix on 2/2/2025. Sermon Series: Hebrews; Jesus is Greater! Main Passage: Hebrews 2:5-18

Opened with a discussion about James Donald Bowman who went by the nickname, "JD".

- Due to drug addiction, he would be raised by his **maternal** grandparents.

- His name was changed to James David Hamel. He graduated from High School and joined the <u>Marines</u>. He used GI Bill to go to Ohio State University and eventually graduated Law School at <u>Yale</u>. After marriage, he changed his last name to "<u>Vance</u>", in honor of his grandparents who raised him.

- He is the third youngest <u>Vice President</u> in US History, and the first <u>millennial</u> to become Vice President.

- JD rose from nothing to one of the highest offices in our land. <u>Jesus</u> left Heaven to be born as a man, and now reigns over all creation.

1) Kingdom Formed

- What new world is the author is talking about is the one to come following <u>Jesus</u> second coming. (ref: Isa.65:17, 66:22; 2Pet.3:12-13; Rev.21:1)

- The New World will not be subject to <u>Angels</u>, but to Jesus and His joint heirs. (ref: v.5; Dan.7:27; Rev.20:4&6; 2Tim.2:12; 1Pet.2:9)

- The meaning of Jesus being "King of Kings" and "Lord of Lords" will also be true of the New World to come.

2) Kingdom Lost

- In the beginning, God gave <u>mankind</u> dominion over the Earth, but <u>Satan</u> and his Demons gained control after mankind fell into sin. (ref: Rev.12:7-9; Dan.10:20; Eph. 2:1-3, 6:12)

3) Kingdom <u>Restored</u>

Jesus became a man, who is currently lower than <u>Angels</u>, in order to redeem mankind. If Jesus is reigning now, why is there still suffering, pain, and evil? That won't happen till after His <u>second</u> coming during the New Earth. (vs.6-9; Rom.8:22-23; 1John 2:16-17)
<u>God</u> had to become like us in order to save us. He had to live a righteous <u>life</u> that we couldn't and die the **death** we deserved. (vs.10-18)

- Jesus' sacrifice spares His followers from experiencing the <u>second</u> death. (ref: v.9; Rev.21:8)

- We who believe have <u>died</u> with Christ and have been <u>raised</u> from the dead. (ref: Rom.6:3-4, 6; Col.2:12-13)

In closing,

- Ultimately, <u>Jesus</u> calls us brothers and sisters. Jesus had to become a man in order to save mankind and return us to our proper position.
